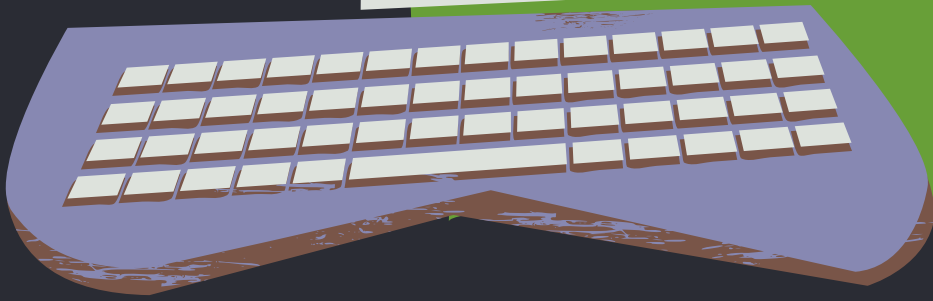


VALLEY RANCH MUD NO. 1



- Never blow grass or lawn waste into the storm sewer
- Bag it for licensed waste haulers to transport or compost the waste into mulch
- Water the lawn during the early hours of the morning or late in the evening to maximize water absorption



- Always dispose of waste in appropriate, secure receptacles
- Household Hazardous waste are very common in residential areas
- If not disposed of properly, litter and trash may wash into the storm sewer, harming local ecosystems

- Always read the label before spraying pesticides or herbicides
- Improper application can wash pesticides and herbicides into local waterways
- This can negatively impact our drinking water and impede fishing and other forms of contact recreation

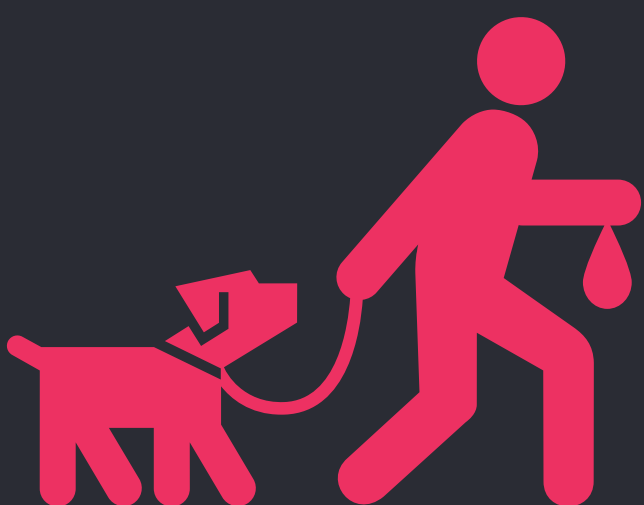


NEVER FORGET TO PICK UP YOUR PET WASTE!



1 DO IT NOW

Step one, of course, is to capture your pet's waste in either a plastic bag or a biodegradable bag.



2 TAKE BABY STEPS

Tie the bag tightly to remove the air for proper disposal!

3 FORGET IT

Put the bag with your pet waste inside another bag before you throw it away in your garbage bin at home or a designated bin at the park.



4 ALL DONE!

Failure to pick up pet waste can allow it to be carried, by rainwater, directly into our local water bodies. Thanks for doing your part!
