**SOLUTIONS TO HELP OUR WATERWAYS**

## **SMARTER LAWN CARE**

Use fertilizers and pesticides carefully - too much can run off into stormwater, harming aquatic life.

## **CLEAN UP PET WASTE**

Pet waste carries bacteria that washes into waterways. Always scoop it, bag it, and trash it.

## **LAWN DEBRIS & STORM DRAINS**

Keep grass clippings, leaves, and yard waste out of streets and storm drains - they can add nutrients to waterbodies that cause algae blooms, as well as block drainage, leading to localized flooding.

## **PREVENT ILLEGAL DUMPING & TRASH**

Never pour oil, paint, or chemicals in storm drains - they flow untreated into nearby waterbodies.
